NORTH CANTON, Ohio, September 26, 2013 - The North Canton Public Library is excited to announce they will be hosting a community involvement fair Saturday, November 16, 2013 from 12 – 2:30 p.m. The fair aims to assist community members in finding a volunteer or service opportunity that is a great match for them. “The library averages 750 patrons through our doors each day, and we’d love to introduce those people to local non-profit organizations as they begin to look for ways to “give back” during the upcoming holiday season,” explained community relations manager, Christina Weyrick-Cooper.

In fact, the library will dedicate the entire month of November to exploring the world of giving and community. In addition to the community involvement fair, the library will host programs presented by the Canton Chapter of the Foundation for Community Betterment and will encourage patrons to distribute Betterment’s “be the good” cards. The library will also partner with Project REBUILD on a “Warm Paws” dog house building project, in which teens and middle school students will build and paint dog houses to be donated to the Stark County Humane Society for distribution to dogs in our community who do not have proper housing.

The North Canton Public Library is committed to corporate social responsibility including programs like this involvement fair, and our ongoing monthly “Meet the Need” program in which we promote and collect in-kind donations for Stark County non-profit organizations.
